Try SCUBA

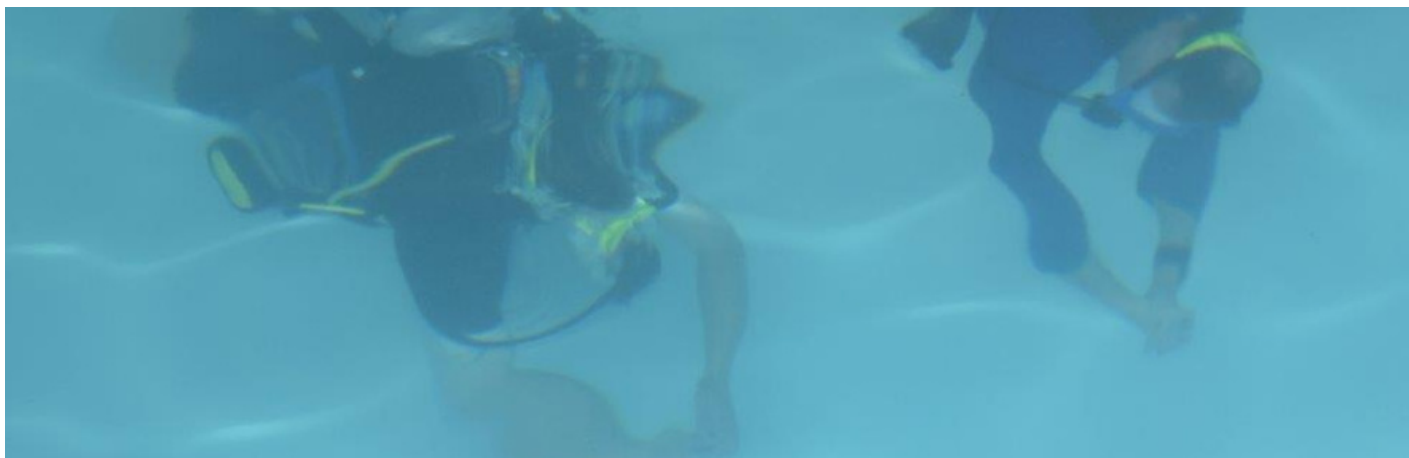
