Family Fishing and Archery Outing

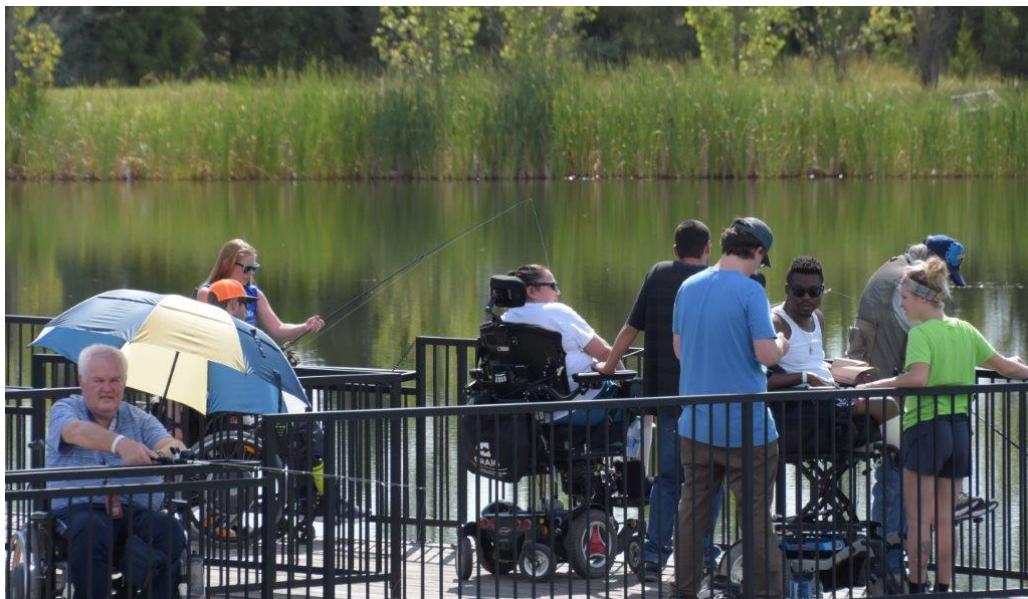
